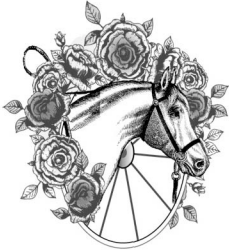

Singles are encouraged to have a groom/passenger; pairs and tandems are required to have one groom. Very small equine entries may have one groom for pairs and tandems. Passengers are encouraged.

Whips under age 14 must be accompanied by a capable adult. All whips must wear a hat, gloves, apron and carry a whip. All passengers in the carriages must wear hats.

The order of entries in the parade is: VSEs go first, then ponies, then horses, progressing to the largest draft teams and concluding with the coach. Upon arrival at Boston University Tanglewood Institute, please report to the parade coordinators to receive your number and any last minute instructions. There is limited stabling for out of town entries. Please call 413-441-4682 to reserve.

If there is any question about weather, a final decision on postponement will be made by 9:00 am on Saturday the 9th. If in doubt, please call Harvey Waller at 413-441-4682 or Maureen Gamelli at 413-822-1028. Status will be posted on the club web site: www.colonialcarriage.org.

Please give yourself enough time to decorate your carriage, harness and hitch your horses, attend the brunch and briefing and drive up Yokun Avenue by 1:15 pm sharp!!

In the parade, it is extremely important that you maintain your place in line. Do not pass other vehicles. Plan your spacing to accomplish this. We will go around the parade route twice.

All drivers must be members of the Colonial Carriage & Driving Society to be covered by insurance. Memberships will be available the day of the show or include your membership with the entry form.

CURRENT COGGINS AND RABIES CERTIFICATES AND SIGNED WAIVER MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES.

Directions to Boston University Tanglewood Institute, 45 West St, Lenox MA.

From Boston and points east: take Exit 2 off the Mass Pike (Rt.90) on to Rt.20 W through Lee for 5 miles, then turn left on Walker Street to Main St then straight on 183/West St. for about .3 miles. Institute on the left.

From Albany and points west: take the NY State Thruway extension into Massachusetts (I90/Mass Pike) and take Exit 2 into Lee and Lenox. Follow the directions from Boston (above).

From Pittsfield and points north: take Rt. 7 S to Rt. 7A/to Main St Lenox, then right on 183/West St.

From Stockbridge and points south: take Rt.7 N for 5 miles to the first traffic signal, Rt. 7A/Kemble Street. Left on to Walker Main then straight on 183/West St.
